We are very excited to be holding our Junior School Harvest Festival service this year in one of the barns at Bartonsham Dairy, by kind permission of Mr & Mrs P Matthews. This event will therefore not be in the Cathedral as printed in this term's school calendar.

As part of our Harvest Festival we will be supporting the charity 'Send a Cow' www.sendacow.org. The pupils will be learning about this charity during assembly at the beginning of next week. To raise funds for this excellent cause all the children (Reception - Year 6) are being asked to wear their (clean!) wellies to school on Thursday 27th September and bring a £1 donation.
