BOOK FAIR – Monday 21st May

Following its success in February, the Junior School will once again be holding a Book Fair during the afternoon of **Monday 21st May** in **St David's Hall**.

The Children's Bookshelf is a local company stocking thousands of new books and is a specialist in Pop-Up Book events. In addition, the Junior School will earn a FREE book for every ten books purchased through the book fair.

All the books are £2 and range from picture books for the younger ones to chapter books for readers up to 13+. Children in some classes will have the opportunity to browse the book fair in the afternoon but it will remain open until **5pm** for you to come and purchase books too. We would ask that parents only come from **3.15pm** onwards to give the children time to visit the book fair with their teachers.

Having seen the enthusiasm with which the children browsed the books last time, it is hoped that even more books will be sold this time. If you would like to participate, please send your child with £2 in a named envelope to school on Monday 21st May.

As a school we encourage the children to read regularly and widely and we hope that the opportunity to buy their own book will contribute to the children's enjoyment of reading.
