In support of the Y6 PSHE curriculum the pupils in Y6 will be attending a 'Crucial Crew' event at Leominster Police Station on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> June. This is an event specifically designed for Y6 pupils in the county and attended by nearly 2000 Y6 pupils across Herefordshire over a 2 week period.

'Crucial Crew' is organised by West Mercia Police in partnership with Hereford & Worcester Fire & Rescue Service (HWFR) and is a series of workshops aiming to equip the children with skills to keep them fit and healthy throughout their lives and to prepare them for some of the issues they may face as they grow from being children to young people in the coming years.

Workshops are delivered by partners such as Western Power, Network Rail, HWFR, Emotional Well Being, Road Safety, Strong Young Minds, Dogs Trust, HOPE and West Mercia Police.

The event will take place during the normal school day and the children will depart at 8.45am and return at 3pm.

Pupils should wear school tracksuits and bring a coat or cagoule in case of inclement weather. There will be no charge for this trip and the pupils will not require any spending money. Packed lunches will be provided for those who normally have school lunches.
