Please Note

We strongly recommend that you create an Adobe ID and install the VLeBooks Application, a free eBook reader app which supports Digital Rights Management (DRM) for books purchased from VLeBooks on your android device.

Why should I create an Adobe ID and install the VleBooks App?

VLeBooks eBooks contain Adobe DRM which stands for Digital Rights Management and is the recognised industry standard within the eBook marketplace.


DRM is used to help prevent software piracy. It works by permanently linking an owner's device with purchased digital content so that it cannot be copied and distributed illegally. This protects both the buyer and the publisher. The person who has purchased the content may copy it to any six compatible devices they own.

*VLeBooks eBooks are not compatible with Amazon Kindle.

Creating an Adobe ID account

To create an Adobe ID Account, go to: <https://www.adobe.com/account/sign-in.adobedotcom.html> or [Click Here](#) and then click the 'Don't have an Adobe ID?' link.

Complete the form and scroll to the bottom of the page and click 'Create'.

You can keep up to date with developments and updates from Adobe by ticking the Keep me informed box.

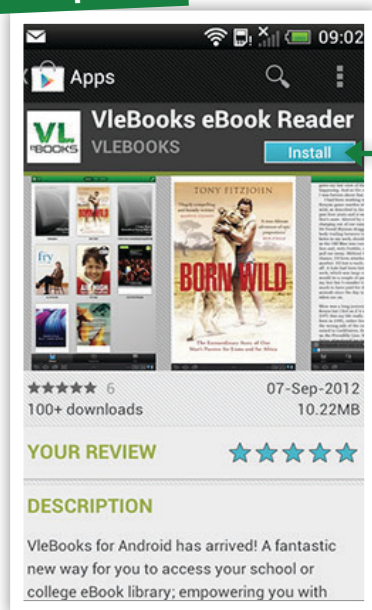
When your details are all filled in please press the create button to continue

Download and setup the VLeBooks Application to an Android Device

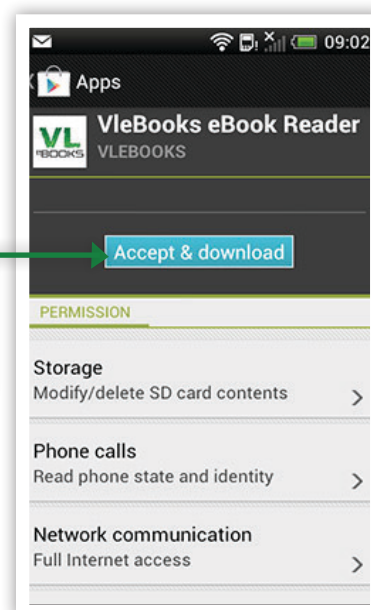
Step One

On your device visit the Google Play Store app and search for 'VleBooks'.

Step Two



Open the Play Store App on your device and search for VLeBooks. Press VLeBooks and then press Install.



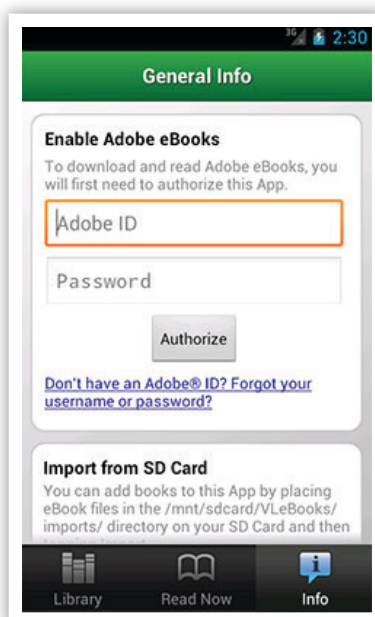
When prompted, press 'Accept & download' to begin installing the App. You will be notified when the App finishes installing.

Step Three

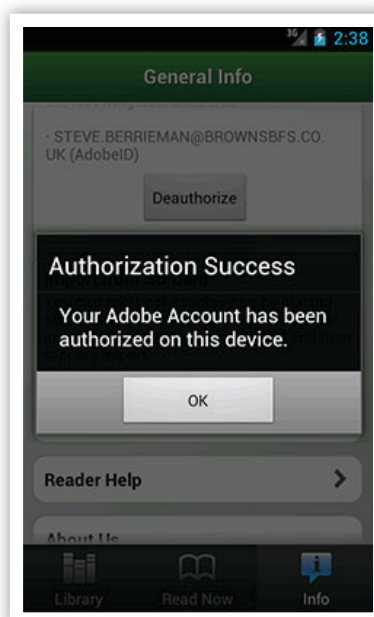
Click the VLeBooks icon on your device to open the App. You will be taken to your Library, which currently doesn't have any books in it.



Before you download a book into VLeBooks for Android, open the app on your device and click the 'Info' button on the bottom toolbar.



Enter your Adobe ID and password, and press 'Authorize'.



If successful, you will receive a confirmation message like this. Press ok. You are now ready to download your first book!

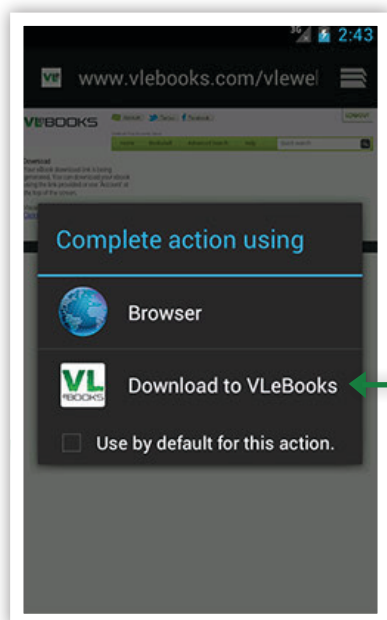
Downloading eBooks into you VLeBooks Application

Step One

To begin downloading eBook in to your application on your Android device you must now use the internet browser on your Android and navigator to www.vlebooks.com, once loaded please log in using the username and password provide by Browns Books for Students.

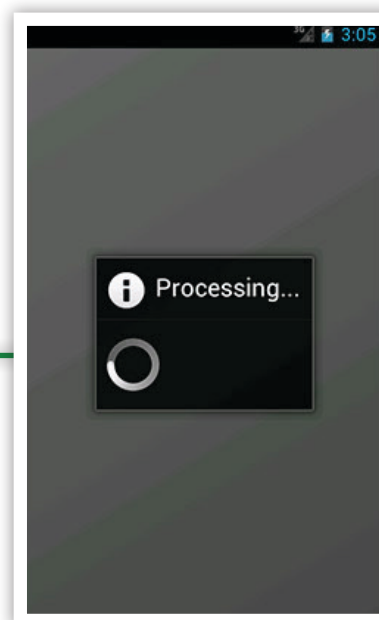
Step Two

Search for the book you want to download, and press the Download button. Choose how many days you wish to download it for and press Download.



Once generated, click the Download link, and when prompted click 'Download to VLeBooks'.

This will start the download of the book into VLeBooks for Android.



Step Three

Once complete, you will be asked whether you wish to be taken to your library, or read the book now. Pressing 'Read Now' will open the book for you to begin reading!
